



## José Martí MAST 6-12 Academy

### Requirements to Remain in Good Standing



In order to be successful and remain in good standing while enrolled in José Martí MAST 6-12 Academy, students must meet the following criteria:

- Students who are on probation for more than one grading period within the school year may not be eligible to return to José Martí MAST 6-12 Academy the following school year.
- Students who receive at least one academic grade of D or F in any class on their report card will be placed on probation for the following grading period.
  - Students in grades 6-8 must maintain a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average in academics.
  - Students in grades 9-12 must maintain a minimum of a 2.5 UNWEIGHTED grade point average in academics.
- Students who receive at least one conduct grade of D or F in any class on their report card will be placed on probation for the following grading period.
  - Students must maintain a minimum of 2.0 grade point average in conduct.
- In order for middle school students to transition to the 9<sup>th</sup> grade at José Martí MAST 6-12 Academy, they must have a minimum of 2.5 grade point average at the completion of 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Attendance, punctuality, and active participation are crucial to a student's academic success. Therefore, students may be placed on probation if they accumulate more than 5 absences and/or tardies. Any medical or serious concerns relating to attendance or tardies must be discussed in a timely manner with an administrator.
- Parents are required to register for a Dade Schools Parent Portal account in order to actively monitor their child's grades.

I have read and understand the requirements for my child to remain in good standing at José Martí MAST 6-12 Academy. I understand that failure to meet the above criteria may result in my child being placed on probation and possibly being withdrawn from the school.
